REQUEST FOR REPLACEMENT DD FORM 214, "CERTIFICATE OF RELEASE OR DISCHARGE FROM ACTIVE DUTY"

When a brother knight dies and final arrangements are being made, the DD Form 214 or an equivalent document will be required to be brought to a funeral home director so that they can contact the appropriate military Service to provide graveside Military Funeral Honors. Unfortunately, many individuals have misplaced their DD 214 and the family will be unable to locate it in their time of need. A replacement DD 214 can be requested from the National Archives and Record Administration, NARA, at their National Personnel Records Center, in Saint Louis, MO. If you are a veteran or the next of kin of a deceased veteran, you may now use this web site "vetrecs.archives.gov" to order a copy of your military records. For all others, your request is best made using a Standard Form 180, "Request Pertaining to Military Records" which can be accessed from the following web site "<http://www.archives.gov/st-louis/military-personnel/index.html>." The SF 180 includes complete instructions for preparing and submitting requests.

I hope you find this information useful and if you are not successful in locating your original DD 214, 'Discharge papers' that you do contact NARA and request a copy of this important document

Please be aware that the Columbus Club Board of Directors recently approved a "Special Pool Assessment Fee" of \$100.00 that will be added to the discounted pool membership dues ("Knight Family dues") for those members who have not paid their Knights of Columbus dues by April 1st of each year.

The Board of Directors believed that this action was necessary to encourage Knights to pay their annual membership fees in the Knights of Columbus in a more timely fashion. As you well know, annual membership dues in the Knight of Columbus must be paid in full before a Knight is entitled to receive the "Knight Family" dues rate for their pool membership fees. However, the unfortunate recent trend has been that many members have been waiting to pay their Knights of Columbus dues until they are ready to pay their pool membership fees. Considering that membership is annual and runs from January 1 to December 31, this trend has deprived the Columbus Club of the availability to use dues money to help support our facilities through the "slow months" associated with the first part of the year.
