### REQUEST FOR REPLACEMENT DD FORM 214, "CERTIFICATE OF RELEASE OR DISCHARGE FROM ACTIVE DUTY"

When a brother knight dies and final arrangements are being made, the DD Form 214 or an equivalent document will be required to be brought to a funeral home director so that they can contact the appropriate military Service to provide graveside Military Funeral Honors. Unfortunately, many individuals have misplaced their DD 214 and the family will be unable to locate it in their time of need. A replacement DD 214 can be requested from the National Archives and Record Administration, NARA, at their National Personnel Records Center, in Saint Louis, MO. If you are a veteran or the next of kin of a deceased veteran, you may now use this web site "vetrees.archives.gov" to order a copy of your military records. For all others, your request is best made using a Standard Form 180, "Request Pertaining to Military Records" which can be accessed from the following web site "http://www.archives.gov/st-louis/ military-personnel/index.html." The SF 180 includes complete instructions for preparing and submitting requests.

I hope you find this information useful and if you are not successful in locating your original DD 214, 'Discharge papers' that you do contact NARA and request a copy of this important document
