40-DAY PRO-LIFE PRAYER VIGIL—"Jesus said to Peter, So, could you not watch one hour with me?" (Mt. 26:40)

The visible public centerpiece of the campaign is a 40-day prayer vigil outside the abortion site at 900 S. Washington Street in Falls Church. (Directions are available). A small committee has been formed and has been brain-storming (ouch!) to come up with ideas to enhance both the menu and the overall appeal of the Supper Club. Starting with the two Friday Night Supper Clubs scheduled in October (see menus & details in this Knight Life) we will be offering an expanded and more varied menu. We also plan to solicit suggestions and entree requests from customers.
