Dues Notices The Third Quarter dues notices were mailed in mid-June. If you have not received your notice, please telephone the office and leave a message so that I can contact you and make sure that I have your current information.

Delinquent Members Over the past few months, the subject of delinquent members has been a focal point of my monthly reports, simply because of the significant financial drain they have on the Council finances. My efforts to resolve this issue have not been limited to publishing this column. In fact, I personally wrote to approximately 90 members (who have been delinquent since the end of 2003) to inform them of their delinquency, provide them with the opportunity to bring their membership current and inform them of the procedures that they should follow if they decided to withdraw from membership. I am pleased to report to the membership that of those 90, I have received nearly 30 responses, the overwhelming majority of which were withdrawals.

While I know that this does not bode well for our membership goals, I would like to frame this in the light of success because these withdrawals will have a significant positive impact upon our treasury- about \$6,000 worth. On an even more positive note, I am happy to report that five of those responses brought their membership into a current status! Additionally, I am working with a couple more and anticipate that they will come back "into the fold" soon. Because of the success of these efforts, I would like to afford the remaining delinquent members a little more time to respond and I have decided to publish the names of delinquents next month.

I wish to say "thank you" to those honorable gentlemen that were contacted and took the time to respond. I look forward to hearing from more of you in the coming weeks.

Concerned Members Since beginning my campaign to reduce our delinquent members, I have received a few calls or notes from members who are concerned that their name may appear in a future column because they are a quarter behind on their dues. Be aware that I do not intend to publish names of these members, as my campaign focuses on seriously delinquent members- not those who may have overlooked their statement!

Responsibility for Dues When Your Membership Status Changes Please be aware that when you have met the requirements to change your membership status (such as to Honorary Life Member), only your Knights of Columbus dues are affected by the change. You are still required to pay your Columbus Club dues of \$38 each year. I recognize that you cannot be officially suspended for failure to pay your Columbus Club dues; but failing to pay your "home association" dues only hurts your Brothers and the property that you have enjoyed over the years. Please be Catholic gentlemen and consider how you may affect your Brother Knights and hurt your club when you refuse to pay Columbus Club dues.
