FROM THE DESK OF THE FINANCIAL SECRETARY

Dues Payments: The 2009 dues amount has increased by \$5.00 in accordance with the 2003 Columbus Club resolution to increase dues by \$2.00 each year and the Supreme Council's special assessment of \$3.00. Regular Members' dues are \$119; Honorary Members' dues are \$65; and, Honorary Life Members dues are \$46 (Columbus Club dues only). When paying your dues, inclusion of your dues notice will expedite the processing of your check, but is not necessary. As such, you can simply drop your check in the mail and I will credit your account. Remember, paying your dues in full minimizes administrative costs and helps the Council, overall.

When paying your dues, please remember to add a few dollars to the "Penny a Knight a Day (PKD) Fund, the Building Fund, and the Charity Fund.

Annual Meeting: Please remember that you must be a "member in good standing" (defined as a Knight who pays his dues) to be admitted to the Annual Columbus Club Meeting. Payments will be accepted at the door.

Honorary Life Members: As you well know, the Supreme Constitution provides that Honorary Life Members (HLM) receive a full exemption from the payment of Council dues. However, there continues to be misunderstandings of the rules concerning Columbus Club dues. Please be aware that the By-Laws of the Columbus Club DO NOT provide for the exemption, or reduction, of dues for these special members. As such, HLMs are reminded that they are OBLIGATED, as Catholic Gentlemen, to pay Columbus Club dues (\$46) in order to ensure that sufficient funds are available for the operation of the grounds.

This having been said, I assure you that the Council Officers, Columbus Club Board Members, and I will go out of our way to accommodate HLMs who may be experiencing financial problems. If you are an HLM (a treasured member) who needs an accommodation, please contact me immediately to discuss potential options. However, in keeping with the previous ruling of the State Advocate, HLMs who fail to pay or contact me will remain members in good standing and permitted to attend Council meetings. However, they will NOT be permitted to utilize Columbus Club facilities.

Please Be Kind: Remember that the fraternal side of the KofC is run entirely by people who "step up to the plate" and sacrifice countless hours to make EDW run. We all try our best, but despite every effort, mistakes happen on my part- and yours. With that said, please considerate when you report a problem. I am happy to help anyone who has an inquiry or problem (that's why I took this job). But when a member is rude, abusive or insulting, they send a very discouraging message to me. Remember, I can be as helpful to you as you are kind to me...

Inquiries: If you should have a concern over your dues account, please email me at fs2473@hotmail.com. Believe it or not, I have a special phone dedicated to Council business (I pay for it out of my own pocket) and it's so "high tech" that I receive emails as you send them. As such, I am pretty quick to acknowledge the email I receive, so you can be confident that you sent your email to the right address and that I am aware of your issue. Contrary to the belief of some, I am not at the Council 24 hours per day and seven

days per week, so your email provides me with a "tickler" to help me remember to look into your problem when I am there.

Belated Birthday greetings to our December birthday girls: Jo Wood and Ann Einsiedler. And in January, say Happy Birthday to Pat Conroy.

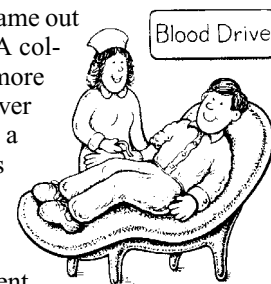
Many the new year bring you all much joy and happiness. Thanks again for your support.

REVEREND LOUIS J. GAGNARD



EDW Council 2473 was saddened recently with the passing of one of their beloved Chaplains for the past 10 years, Reverend Louis J. Gagnard on November 3, 2008.

Father Gagnard came to EDW from retirement in the Diocese of Arlington where he was doing research and writing about Church teachings. He was a life member of the Knights of Columbus and a former Chancellor of the Diocese of Alexandria Louisiana. He had served that diocese for

31 years prior to his retirement in 1991. His last parish was Immaculate Heart of Mary in Louisiana.

Prior to his service in Louisiana, he was a chaplain for the U.S. Navy and will be interred in Arlington National Cemetery. He is survived by a brother and sister in Louisiana and all of the members of EDW for which he provided such faithful service.

He was born on May 20, 1921 and ordained on May 8, 1952.

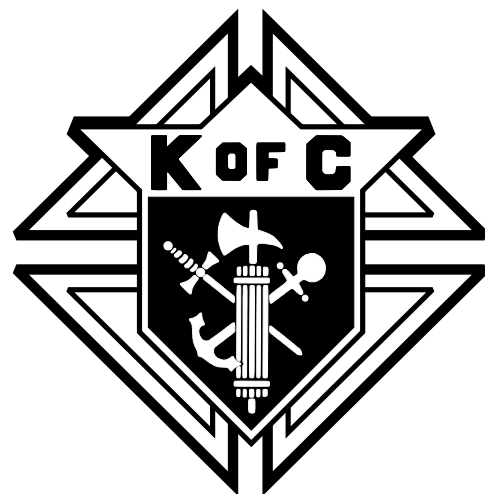

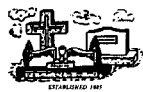
