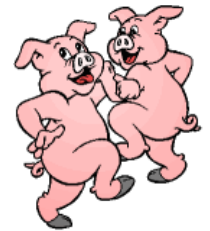

HOLY MACKERELS OFF TO 3-0 START

AKC Now Tops Colonial Swim League's Gold Division

The Arlington Knights of Columbus (AKC) Holy Mackerels swim team is off to a terrific start this season, with a 3-0 record, as of press time mid-July, and a co-leader spot atop the Colonial Swim League's (CSL) Gold Division. This season's team is the Mackerels' largest, made up of 250 swimmers from more than 135 families.

AKC came out strong in its season opener at Glen Cove June 26, dominating the Pirates 406-22. The Mackerels' mixed-age boys 200 free relay team of Charlie Beirne, Shahan Jayasinghe, Matias Moreno, and Daniel Mullen broke the yard record.

The Mackerels then swam past the Chinquapin Wahoos July 3, 277-167, at AKC, to earn their second straight win of the season.

AKC continued its winning streak July 10, when the Mackerels defeated the Saratoga Stingrays, 261-183. The pouring rain at Saratoga didn't stop the Mackerels from breaking several team records. One exciting turnabout involved the 11-12 boys 50-meter backstroke record: The preceding week, in action against the Chinquapin Wahoos, AKC's Matias Moreno broke the team record with a new time of 36.92, which was held previously by Nicolas Reeves. Reeves reclaimed his record July 10 with a new time of 36.84.

The Mackerels' mixed aged boys 200-meter freestyle relay also broke a 14-year-old team record July 10 with a new time of 2:12.34. Relay members were Daniel Mullen, Nicolas Reeves, Shahan Jayasinghe, and Chris Lent. And the Mackerels' 11-12 boys 200-meter medley relay set a new record with a time of 2:39.34. Relay members were Jake Smerchansky, Matias Moreno, Nicolas Reeves and Aidan Zito.

Leading the way for the Mackerels in individual swims this season are Charlie Beirne, Kathleen Butler, Elizabeth Dufrane, Shahan Jayasinghe, Matias Moreno, Daniel Mullen and India Seldin, who have each had triple wins. Isabel Barnidge, Andrew Deabler, Nicolas Reeves, and Malia Rivera have each earned double wins.

The Holy Mackerels' season continues through the end of July and culminates with a team swim banquet at AKC August 1.
