## FROM THE DESK OF THE FINANCIAL SECRETARY

**Dues Payments:** Per my column last month, Columbus Club dues will increase \$2.00 this year. Members will also be subject to a special assessment of \$6.00 per member to maintain Supreme's 'Culture of Life Fund' to further and promote the teachings of the Catholic Church with respect to matters affecting life, family, marriage and similar issues. Due to communication issues with Supreme, we failed to collect the assessment in 2010 and has been doubled to recoup the out of pocket payment we made. Considering the size of our Council, this assessment was a significant expense that must be passed on to the membership in order to maintain our financial health.

Dues for Regular Members dues will be \$126; Honorary Members dues will be \$70, Honorary Life Members dues will be \$50 (they are exempted from the Special Assessment and are required to pay Columbus Club dues only).

When paying your dues, please remember to add a few dollars to the "Penny a Knight a Day (PKD) Fund, the Building Fund, and the Charity Fund.

**Honorary Life Members:** As you well know, the Supreme Constitution provides that Honorary Life Members (HLM) receive a full exemption from the payment of Council dues. However, there continues to be misunderstandings of the rules concerning Columbus Club dues. Please be aware that the By-Laws of the Columbus Club DO NOT provide for the exemption, or reduction, of Columbus Club dues for these special members. As such, HLMs are reminded that they are OBLIGATED, as Catholic Gentlemen, to pay Columbus Club dues (\$50) in order to help ensure that sufficient funds are available for the operation of the grounds.

This having been said, I assure you that the Council Officers, Columbus Club Board Members, and I will go out of our way to accommodate HLMs who may be experiencing financial problems. If you are an HLM (a treasured member) who needs an accommodation, please contact me immediately to discuss potential options. However, in keeping with the previous ruling of the State Advocate, HLMs who fail to pay or contact me will remain members in good standing and permitted to attend Council meetings. However, they will NOT be permitted to utilize Columbus Club facilities.

**Annual Meeting:** Please remember that you must be a “member in good standing” (defined as a Knight who pays his dues) to be admitted to the Annual Columbus Club Meeting. Payments will be accepted at the door.

Please remember that a “member in good standing” is defined simply as a Brother Knight who pays his dues. But when a member doesn’t pay dues, he hurts the Council finances, as there are significant costs associated with each membership (e.g., State and Supreme dues that MUST be paid, even if a member does not pay). So, when members fail to pay, they unnecessarily increase the costs to this charitable organization and impact our ability to help others.

As you will be reading this in the later part of December, I wanted to make sure that all Brothers mark their calendars and attend the Annual Corporation meeting to be held at the Main Hall on Thursday, January 6, 2010 at 7:30 pm.



Approval of the 2011 Corporation Budget – very important.


